- † To adhere to and abide by the complete Word of God, which is The Holy Bible.



THE MUSIC MINISTRY

The Music Ministry of New Tabernacle Missionary Baptist Church is an integral part of each worship service.

The **VOICES** consist of adults, 18 years old and over. The **Male Chorus** is comprised of men also age 18 and over. The **C. B. Curtis Choir** consists of the “Junior” C. B. C.’s age 4-12, and the “Senior” C. B. C.’s who are 13-17 years old.

The Praise Team consists of selected members from each choir who usher in The Holy Spirit at the beginning of each worship service.

Sunday morning worship services are enhanced with the melodic sounds of each choir. The schedule is as follows:
 1st Sunday: Mass Choir
 2nd Sunday: Male Chorus
 3rd Sunday: C.B. Curtis Choir
 4th Sunday: The VOICES
 5th Sunday: Praise Team

Each choir is called upon at various times throughout the year to help support the worship service of other ministries within the church, as well as with other churches throughout Northwest Indiana.
